

CREATIVE CODING MULTIMEDIA

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This course is designed to provide the student with an introduction to application software being utilized in the graphics design and computer animation environments. Students will learn basic HTML and how to code by working in a real software development environment to design, program and publish mobile apps and games. Software will include industry standard applications for computer animating, graphic design, and website construction. Software utilized will include: Adobe Flash, Adobe Fireworks, and Adobe Dreamweaver.
